Current Responsibilities

Alex Sciulli is currently a Senior Vice President with Mellon Financial Corporation and serves as the Director of Corporate Operations and Real Estate. He is responsible for Mellon's complete portfolio of real estate both owned and leased (8 million square feet), an annual capital budget of \$85M, and support functions such as security, travel, mail, printing and reprographics, and food services. He is responsible for more than 850 in-house and outsourced employees and an operating budget of more than \$400M. Mr. Sciulli is also a member of Mellon's Senior Management Committee.

Experience

Mr. Sciulli has 30 years experience in the engineering and construction industries. Prior to his affiliation with Mellon, Mr. Sciulli was a Senior Vice President with CDM, one of the largest civil and environmental consulting firms in the U.S. During his tenure at CDM, he was responsible for managing nine regional offices in the mid-Atlantic states with a gross revenue of \$52M.

Prior to CDM, Mr. Sciulli served as the Director of Engineering and Construction for the City of Pittsburgh. His responsibilities included management of the City's infrastructure program for roads, bridges, water and sewer infrastructure, city-owned buildings, and recreational facilities. Mr. Sciulli was responsible for the city's capital program valued at \$500M and managed more than 1,000 employees.

Other experience included several years with Mine Safety and Health Administration a Department of Labor affiliate serving the mining industry, and project management with a local Pittsburgh engineering consulting firm, Orbital Engineering.
