IBC 2012 Call for Awards

Nominations are now being accepted for presentation at the 29th Annual International Bridge Conference[®].

Medals

Projects may be eligible for more than one Medal – select which Medals you believe fit the project on the entry form.

Project Medals

Award winners must be “recent” projects. For all Project Medals, recent is defined as within two years of the Awards ceremony. For example, for the 2012 Award, projects must have been completed between June 2010 and June 2012.

George S. Richardson Medal

For a single, recent, outstanding achievement in bridge engineering; Fields of endeavor may include design, construction, research or education.

Gustav Lindenthal Medal

For a single, recent outstanding achievement in bridge engineering demonstrating, as appropriate, technical and material innovation, **aesthetic merit**, harmony with the **environment** or successful community participation.

Eugene C. Figg Medal

For a single, recent outstanding achievement in bridge engineering that, through vision and innovation, provides an **icon to the community** for which it was designed.

Arthur G. Hayden Medal

For a single recent outstanding achievement in bridge engineering demonstrating innovation in **special use bridges** such as pedestrian, people-mover, or non-traditional structures.

Individual Medal

John A. Roebling Medal

To be awarded to an individual for **lifetime achievement** in bridge engineering. Major achievements may include design, construction, research or educational endeavors.

If you are submitting a project for consideration for multiple Medals, you may submit different descriptions for each Medal if you wish.

PHOTOGRAPHS / DRAWINGS

Photographs and drawings should be submitted electronically on CD-ROM, by e-mail attachment, or comparable media. **We ask for no more than 8 and no fewer than 4 pictures or drawings.** Supporting information that you may provide — photos, drawings, and plans are all acceptable. Any materials that are submitted may be used in conference publications and cannot be returned.
