Brownfields Stimulus Funding

- ARRA provides \$100M stimulus funding to EPA Brownfields Program
- New Job Training Grant Competition (approx \$5M)
- Use ongoing competition to fund additional assessment and cleanup grants (approx \$42M)
- Allocate additional funds to supplemental funding for RLF Grants (approx \$42M)
- Increase Targeted Brownfield Assessment Funds (approx \$8M)

Deadlines-Key Dates

- Job Training Grant Competition
Deadline - April 20, 2009
- Supplemental RLF Deadline – May 1, 2009 (Announcements, May, 2009)
- ARC Grant Announcements –
April/May 2009
- Conference presentations – May 1, 2009

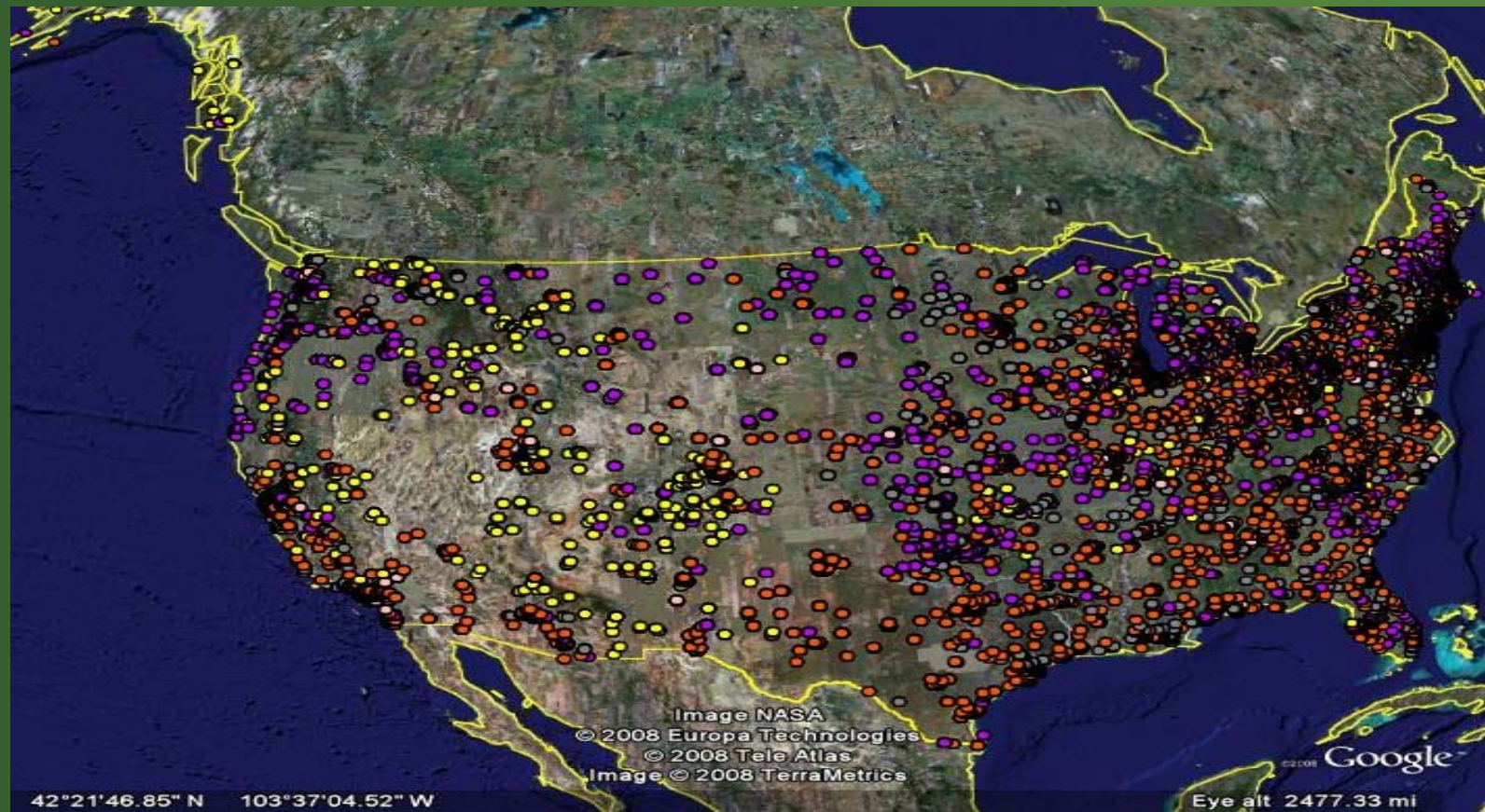

EPA Brownfields Updates

- Leveraged more than \$12.9 billion in cleanup and redevelopment
- Leveraged more than 53,950 jobs
- Supported assessments at more than 13,500 properties
- 2006-2008, State and Tribal Response Programs report
 - Over 142,000 sites are enrolled,
 - More than 31,600 have completed cleanups with ICs in place,
 - 420,609 acres ready for reuse.
